Autumn sowing with Omex fertiliser

1+3= 1

The autumn sowing period represents a time of immense work load for farmers. This problem is increasing as farm units continue to increase in size and numbers of farm staff continue to decline.

As a result, a growing number of farmers are contracting-out fertiliser and herbicide applications to save costs and improve timeliness of autumn operations.

An area where significant savings can be made is the combined application of autumn fertiliser and pre-emergence herbicides.

Omex Agriculture can offer this unique service of applying autumn fertilisers along with pre-emergence herbicides – ideal for cereals and oilseed rape. Not only that: All Omex suspensions now contain Microplus trace elements and in some cases a slug pellet application service is also offered at the same time. 1+3=1.

The suspension fertilisers are concentrated fluid fertilisers which are applied with self-propelled 24 metre sprayers. The fertiliser is delivered to field by road tanker and the contractor mixes the herbicide whilst filling the sprayer and both fertiliser and herbicide are applied extremely accurately.

Approved tank-mixes exist for virtually all of the pre-emergence herbicides (including glyphosate) and the list is given overleaf.
